GETTING STARTED CHECKLIST

The below steps are **REQUIRED** in order for you to qualify for Farm-I-Tude.

- Own an ag spray drone AND be in the process of applying for the necessary FAA exemptions/authorizations
- Have a reserved aircraft registration (N-number)
- Hold a Part 107 certificate
- Have a medical certificate (if you intend to apply at night)
- Hold a state applicator license
 - UNLESS your state requires a Part 137 and certain amount of flying to complete the licensing program → *check your state's requirements*
- Proof of drone insurance
- Set up your Drone Ops Center account → *critical component for reporting purposes*
- Are prepared to complete required knowledge testing (i.e. pass your knowledge tests found within Drone Ops Center)
